Directorate General of Employment and Training, Ministry of Labour and Employment, Government of India issues Eligibility information pertaining to employment in Government Offices for TCO DL Courses Vide Notification No.DGE & T-C-30015/20/2014-EE-I dated 22-12-2014.

According to a directive from MHRD, New Delhi, F.No: 11-1/2013-Sch-3 (Part-I) dated 04-10-2012, it is informed that the Ministry of Human Resource Development does not regulate setting up of education Boards. So Tamilnadu Council for Open and Distance Learning does not come under the scope of MHRD.

Tamilnadu Council Conducts 1 to VII Standard (Elementary Education), VIII Standard (ESLC), Preparatory Programme, IX and X Standard (SSLC), XI and XII Standard (HSLC) and Adult Education. The syllabus has been framed with reference to Tamilnadu State Board Syllabus (Uniform Education Pattern).

On completion and passing of the courses offered by TCO DL the Certificate is issued. This Certificate is valid only for private sector jobs. We do not promise that this certificate is eligible for Government jobs. The students can equip themselves with knowledge to get a private job or they could become an entrepreneur by establishing their own unit and to help the school dropouts, poor people, differently-abled persons, widows and ex-servicemen. This is our primary objective. We kindly request you to verify the credentials of the certificates and its validity before joining the courses offered by TCO DL. Do not believe in any kind of false promises and in case of doubt, kindly call us or mail us or come in person and check the original motive behind the promotion of these courses.
